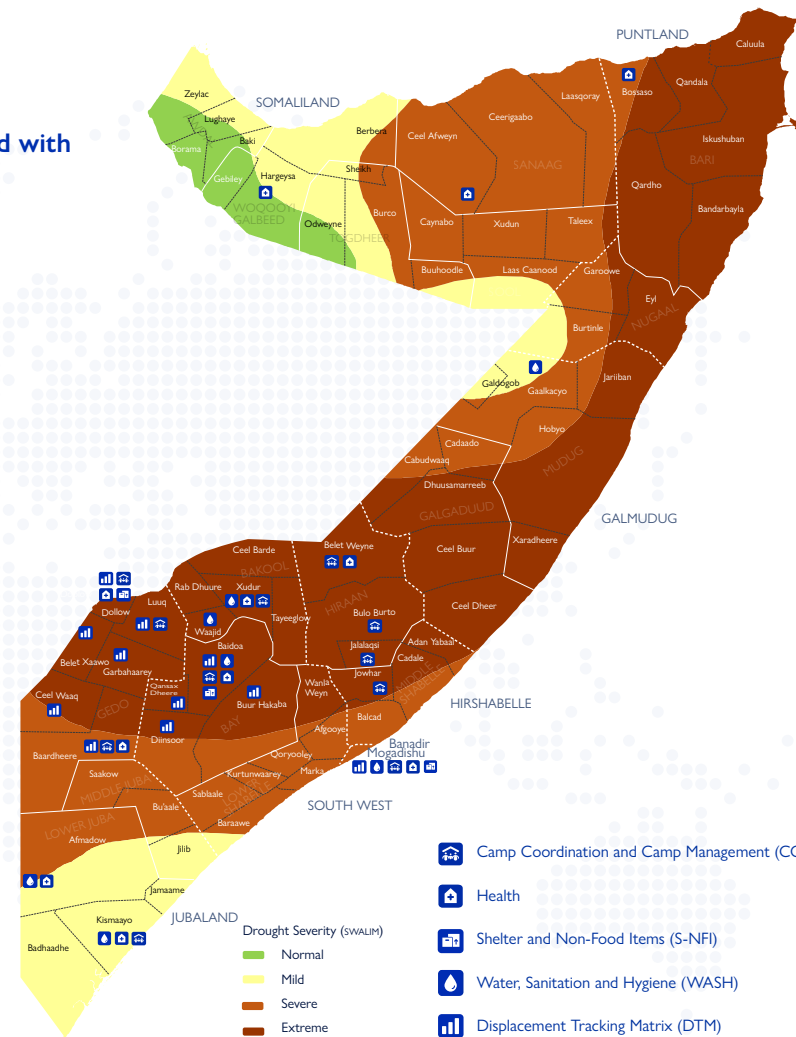
544,800 people assisted with safe water through **103 shallow wells** and **36 boreholes**
